Getting to Work, Delivering Results

- Sponsored 25 bills & 5 resolutions; cosponsored more than 630 bills in the House
 - o 15 Tonko-led bills and resolutions cosponsored by at least one Republican
- Championed and successfully enacted legislation that:
 - o Improves access to medication-assisted treatment for substance use disorder (H.R.3736)
 - o Delivers hope to individuals living with Alzheimer's by unifying federal efforts responding to the disease, driving public research, and more (H.R. 619, H.R. 620, and H.R. 7218)
 - o For the first time ever, **creates a national plan to end Parkinson's disease** (H.R. 2365)

- Tackling climate change and protecting public health & the environment
 - Leader in federal climate action as Ranking Member of the Subcommittee on Environment, Manufacturing, & Critical Materials as well as co-chair of the Sustainable Energy & Environment Coalition (SEEC) and the Bicameral Electrification Caucus
 - Author of H.R. 9131: Indoor Air Quality and Healthy Schools Act; H.R. 9230: Climate Pollution Standard and Community Investment Act; H.R. 8721: Weatherization Enhancement and Readiness Act; H.R. 7054: Federal Carbon Dioxide Removal Leadership Act, and more
- Leading the charge in Congress to address the growing public health crisis of problem gambling through H.R. 9590: Supporting Affordability and Fairness with Every Bet (SAFE Bet) Act
- Championing addiction and mental health treatment & recovery
 - o Co-chair of the bipartisan Addiction Treatment and Recovery (ATR) Caucus
 - Successfully enacted <u>H.R. 3736, the Extending Access to Addiction Treatment Act</u>
 - Author of <u>H.R. 2400, the Reentry Act</u>, which saves lives by restoring access to healthcare for Medicaid-eligible incarcerated individuals 30 days prior to release
 - o Author of bill (H.R. 9886) that expands access to proven and effective addition treatment
- Helped secure hundreds of millions in direct investments for the Capital Region by supporting passage of Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, Inflation Reduction Act, CHIPS & Science Act, and more
