## Grant Policies – 2 CFR 200

---

- 2 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 200 establishes uniform administrative requirements, cost principles, and audit requirements for Federal awards to non-Federal entities.
    - **There are additional requirements per Department, Program, Awarding entity, or equivalent.**
      - ✓ US Department of Health and Human Services – 45 CFR 75
        - Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA)
          - Title X Family Planning Program – 42 CFR 59
  - Purpose:
    - **Define requirements (rules), publish expectations, and provide guidance**

Grant

- Grant – Legal instrument of financial assistance b/t Fed awarding agency and a non-Fed entity consistent with 31 U.S.C. 6302,6304: principal purpose-carry out a public purpose authorized by a law of the US and NOT to acquire property/services for Fed or entity's direct benefit or use.



Cooperative  
Agreement

- Cooperative Agreement – a Grant **PLUS**
- There is substantial involvement b/t the Fed awarding agency and the Non-Fed entity in carrying out the Award
  - The level of involvement is clearly described in the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

## What might affects chances of success?

---

- Read the NOFO instructions carefully and follow them.
  - Page limits, margins
  - File types
  - Electronic submission
  - Federal regulation requirements
- Deadlines are enforced strictly.
- Start early. Submit early. Do not wait until the last minute.
  - Application
  - Sam.gov registration – you must have an active registration at time of submission
  - Partnership documentation (MOUs)

Have realistic expectations.

- It is a competitive process
  - If at first you don't succeed, try again
  - Find a mentor or partner
  - Some awardees may be looking for partners or subrecipients
  - Plan accordingly
  - Be a reviewer

## Things to think about when applying . . .

---

- How special and unique are you?
    - **Is it clear?**
  - What is your story
    - **Your narrative**
  - Objectivity vs Subjectivity
  - What value are you providing: Value= Proposal \* Environment \* Strategy
    - **Value =**
      - ✓ Proposal (what is your intervention)
      - ✓ Environment (where, who, when are being impacted)
      - ✓ Strategy (your technical assets, ability, & demonstrated capability /capacity)
    - **Your proposal must mean something to you as the organization, reflect your mission and values – don't just apply to get funding**
-

## Things to think about when applying . . .

---

- Who is going to read your application
    - **Generally speaking**
      - ✓ subject matter experts
      - ✓ experienced readers
      - ✓ trained to read per the announcement
      - ✓ varied energy level
      - ✓ desire to fund a program that will make a difference
      - ✓ you and me
-

## Things to think about when applying . . .

---

- Budgets
    - **Real costs**
      - ✓ What are the actual costs to carry out your program.
      - ✓ Award funds + matching + in-kind
    - **Future costs**
      - ✓ If funded, can you afford to execute the program at the funded amount
      - ✓ Have you factored in any “unexpected” variance?
      - ✓ Out year escalation costs
    - **Budgeting**
      - ✓ Salaries – pay and benefits
      - ✓ Indirect costs – negotiated or de minimis
-

## Things to think about when applying . . .

---

- New, old, continuing announcement?

## How is the proposal evaluated?

---

- HHS NOFO's will give the specifics for each competition
  - Must meet eligibility requirements to move into the review
  - Review Criteria and Weighting are provided in the NOFO
  - Merit Review in OASH is conducted by the Objective Review Committee (ORC)
    - **Generally non federal staff working through a contractor**
    - **Federal staff only provide technical review and business/risk review of applications scoring well enough for funding.**
  - Office Director decision criteria
    - For example geographic distribution, coverage of focus areas**

## Who makes the award decision?

---

The Program Office Director makes a recommendation to the Grants Management Officer for funding.

The Grants Management Officer reviews risk and administrative factors prior to issuing any award.

The Grants Management Officer is the signatory for the government.



## How are awardees notified?

---

- Awardees will receive a notice of award (NOA) signed by the Grants Management Officer.
- The NOA includes:
  - **Project period (anticipated)**
  - **Budget period (~12 months)**
  - **Federal Project Officer**
  - **Grants Management Specialist**
  - **Standard Terms and Conditions**
  - **Special Terms and Requirements**
  - **Reporting schedules (financial and project)**

**Awardee may be required to address any reviewer comments within the first 30 days of the project period.**

**Awardee may be required to submit a revised budget.**



## How applicants not getting awards are notified?

---

- The OASH Program Offices will contact applicants not receiving awards and provide the reviewer comments.
  - Not all proposals can be funded. This is a competitive process with finite resources available.
  - If additional funds become available, “approved, unfunded” proposals could be awarded in some form.
    - **Note: this process may vary by Agency, program, and/or funding office.**
-

## What are an Awardee's Responsibilities?

---

- Reading and understanding the Notice of Award
  - Standard Terms and Conditions
    - **Timely reporting - project performance and financial**
    - **Allowable, allocable, reasonable and necessary costs (45 C.F.R. Part 75)**
    - **Getting prior approvals when required (Change in Scope, Change in PI/PD, etc.)**
  - Special Terms and Requirements
    - **Cooperative agreement substantial involvement terms**
    - **Submission of IRB approvals to program office**
    - **Risk designation**
  - Communicating with program and grants management
  - Monitoring subawardees
