Child Tax Credit

- Helps families with qualifying children get a tax break of up to \$2,000 per child
- How do you qualify?
 - Your child/dependent is under 17 years old and:
 - Has lived with you for more than half the year
- Claim this credit by entering your child/dependent on <u>Form</u>
 1040
- NOTE: You may be able to claim this credit even if you don't normally file a tax return




Child and Dependent Care Credit

- Gives credit if you paid someone to care for your child or dependent so you could work or look for work
- Credit is calculated by income and a percentage of the expenses you incur for the care of a qualifying person
- How do you qualify?
 - Your child/dependent is under 13 or incapable of self care
 - Your child/dependent has lived with you for more than half the year

Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)



- How do you qualify?
 - Have earned income under \$63,398
 - Have a valid Social Security number
 - Have investment income below \$11,000 in the tax year
