Getting to Work, Delivering Results

- Sponsored 24 bills in the House & cosponsored more than 430 bills
 - 17 bills cosponsored by at least one Republican (more than 70% of bills)
 - Broad House support on legislation, with 229 cosponsors on MAT Act; 177 on Scientific Integrity Act; and 133 on National Heritage Areas Act
- Paving the way for comprehensive U.S. climate action in Congress
 - Holds seat on 3 climate-focused House Committees (Natural Resources, Science Space & Technology and Chair of the Environment & Climate Change Subcommittee)
 - Co-led on <u>**CLEAN Future Act</u>** to tackle climate crisis & achieve net 0 emissions before 2050</u>
 - \circ $\:$ Led on Restoring Offshore Wind Opportunities Act to drive investment in wind energy
- Leading the push for safe, clean drinking water
 - Introduced <u>AQUA Act</u> to address key water infrastructure needs, including removing every one of the estimated 10 million lead service lines in the United States
 - o Supporting PFAS legislation that removes "forever chemicals" from communities
 - Secured **\$55 billion** to repair crumbling water systems under bipartisan infrastructure bill
- Heralded passage of national limousine safety standards
 - Following 2018 Schoharie Limousine tragedy that took the lives of 20, authored Take
 Unsafe Limos Off the Road Act and SAFE Limos Act with families of limo crash victims
 - o Successfully included in bipartisan infrastructure bill **passed into law in November 2021**
- Championing addiction and mental health treatment & recovery
 - Introduced bill <u>examining mental health impacts of pandemic on kids & healthcare workers</u>
 - Led on <u>Medicaid Reentry Act</u> (included in Build Better Act) to restart benefits for Medicaideligible incarcerated individuals 30 days prior to release
 - Improving access to safe, proven addiction treatments under the MAT Act

- Co-chaired Sustainable Energy & Environment Coalition (SEEC), National Heritage Areas Caucus, Horse Caucus, vice co-chair of Addiction, Treatment, and Recovery Caucus, and member of House Energy and Commerce Committee Racial Equity Working Group
- Honors: Humane Legislator of the Year; Energy Vision's 2021 Lifetime Achievement Award
- Ranked **#52 of 435** House members in overall bipartisanship by <u>The Lugar Center</u>
